On the 15th of March, WIL Europe launched the 8th edition of the Women Talent Pool (WTP) leadership programme and closed the 7th edition, with a special online Kick Off/Closing Ceremony for our 57 new Talents and 48 outgoing Talents. The event opened with introductory remarks by WIL Secretary General Pinuccia Contino, Head of the Unit "Product safety and Rapid Alert System" at the European Commission, and was followed by interventions by 7th edition patron Pervenche Berès, Chair of Association Europe Finances Régulations, former Member of the European Parliament and WIL Board Member, and 8th edition patron Cristiana Falcone, non-executive Board Director and Principal at CBF Strategy. In part two of the event, the Talents were able to put questions to their respective patron, after which they moved into a networking session.

Pinuccia Contino opened the session with a welcome to the Talents from both editions. She highlighted why the programme was so important for the WIL network, presented the newly-arrived Talents and recalled some of the best moments from the last 12 months.

#### Ice-breaking **networking session** between WTP7 & WTP8 Talents



The third and final part of the Kick Off and Closing Ceremony was dedicated to a **networking session in small groups**. This saw Talents from the former and current editions of the WTP programme mixed together, enabling the WTP7 Talents to talk about their experience of being on the programme and the WTP8 Talents to put their questions, concerns and expectations to the group. This was a welcome opportunity for our emerging leaders to get to know and support each other, and was an important precursor to WIL's upcoming Annual Gathering in Rome, where the Talents will have the chance to meet each other, and their patrons, in person.
