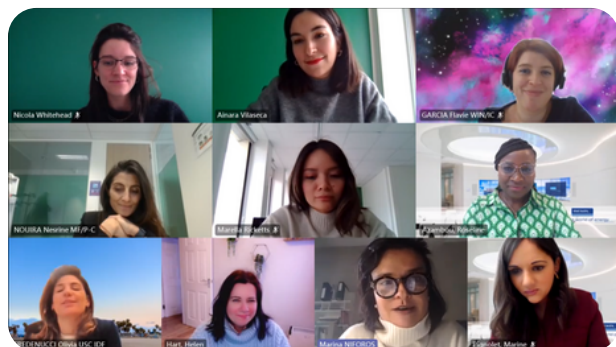

For the eleventh and final workshop of the 7th Women Talent Pool (WTP) programme, our Talents gathered for an online session with WIL Board Member Marina Niforos, Adjunct Professor at HEC Business School in Paris. During the workshop, the second of a two-part module that began in Brussels in March 2022, the Talents had the chance to reflect on their individual leadership journeys since joining the programme. Marina started by recapping some of the key concepts around situational leadership, after which two emerging leaders, Belen Castineira de Anta, Senior Manager Service Delivery at Lenovo, and Marine Pignolet, Development Lead Pricing at Rexel, shared insights into their professional growth over the 12 months and how the WTP had helped them to answer important questions.
